The Always Amanda Organization is proud to present the Fifth Annual Amanda Lynne Byrne Memorial Run/Walk on April 11th, 2015 in Pecos, New Mexico.

The Non-Profit Organization was started in remembrance of Amanda Lynne Byrne. On January 14, 2011 Amanda went on her usual jog wearing her headphones, but because this day was very windy and cold she added a headband as well. While running she encountered a very muddy area from melted snow. To pass she went up on

the train tracks. This turned out to be a fatal mistake. Amanda neither heard nor saw the train coming from behind. In an instant Amanda was gone. The tragic loss of this beautiful 18 year-old continues to be painfully felt by the community and her family.

This run is in honor of Amanda; 100% of the proceeds go toward the Amanda Lynne Byrne Memorial Scholarship. This scholarship is

awarded annually to a Pecos High School Senior that exemplifies character and integrity. Congratulations to the 2014 winner, Angelica Ortiz! She is currently studying at New Mexico State University and we wish her much success.

EVENTS-

The Fun 5k Run/Walk, 10k Run and Kids Fun Run will be held at the Pecos High School track Saturday, April 11, 2015 at 8:00 am.

Registration will be at Pecos High, which is located at the top of the hill on Panther Drive across from the track. Additional signage will be provided race day.

The 10K course is one of the most scenic and historic in all New Mexico. It begins at Pecos High

historic in all New Mexico. It begins at Pecos High School and is within the historic Pecos Pueblo originally called Cicuye. Pecos is often referred to as the "Gateway to the Plains"

and is situated in the midst of the Sangre de Cristo Mountains, Glorieta Mesa and Glorieta Pass to the west. Rich in history the area has seen Pueblo and Plains Indians, Spanish Explorers and Missionaries, Civil War Battles and travelers of the Old Santa Fe Trail. The 10K turnaround is within the *Pecos National Historical Park* where there are remains of a Pueblo and the weathered adobe walls of a Spanish Mission built in the early 1600's which serves as a reminder of cultures that once

RACE DESCRIPTION:

The run will start in front of the Pecos High School. Then proceed to the campus exit. At the bottom of the hill runners will turn right and head in a southerly direction on HWY-63, which is the main thoroughfare of the historical Village of Pecos. The 5k run/walk turnaround will be located on the hill as you leave Pecos (near the rodeo grounds). The 10k run turnaround will be at the Pecos National Historical Park. The runners will run once around the track to finsh the race. The Kids Run will be after the 10K at the Pecos High School Track.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO THE START LINE:

From Santa Fe on I-25 North take **Exit 299** toward NM-50/Glorieta/Pecos. Turn **left** after exiting and head east over I-25. Turn **right** at "T" intersection heading south on NM-50. Continue along NM-50 approximately **5.9 miles**. At stop sign turn **left** heading north on HWY-63. At approximately **0.6 miles** turn **left on Panther Dr**., heading west towards Pecos Schools. At top of hill stay right for parking and start of race.
